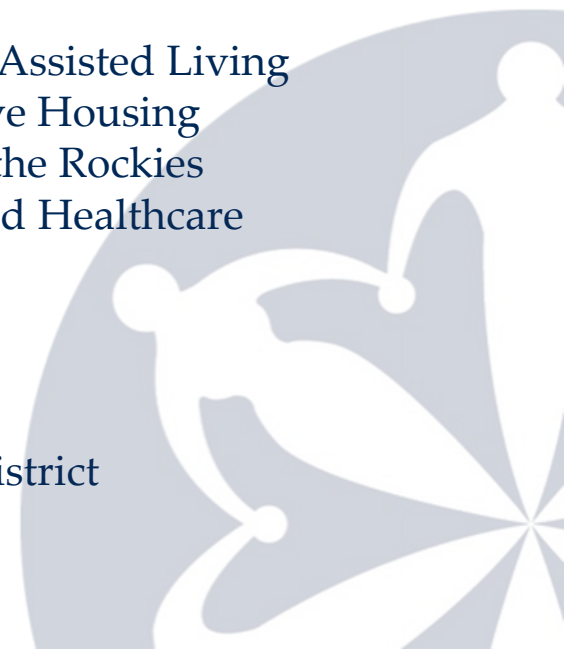

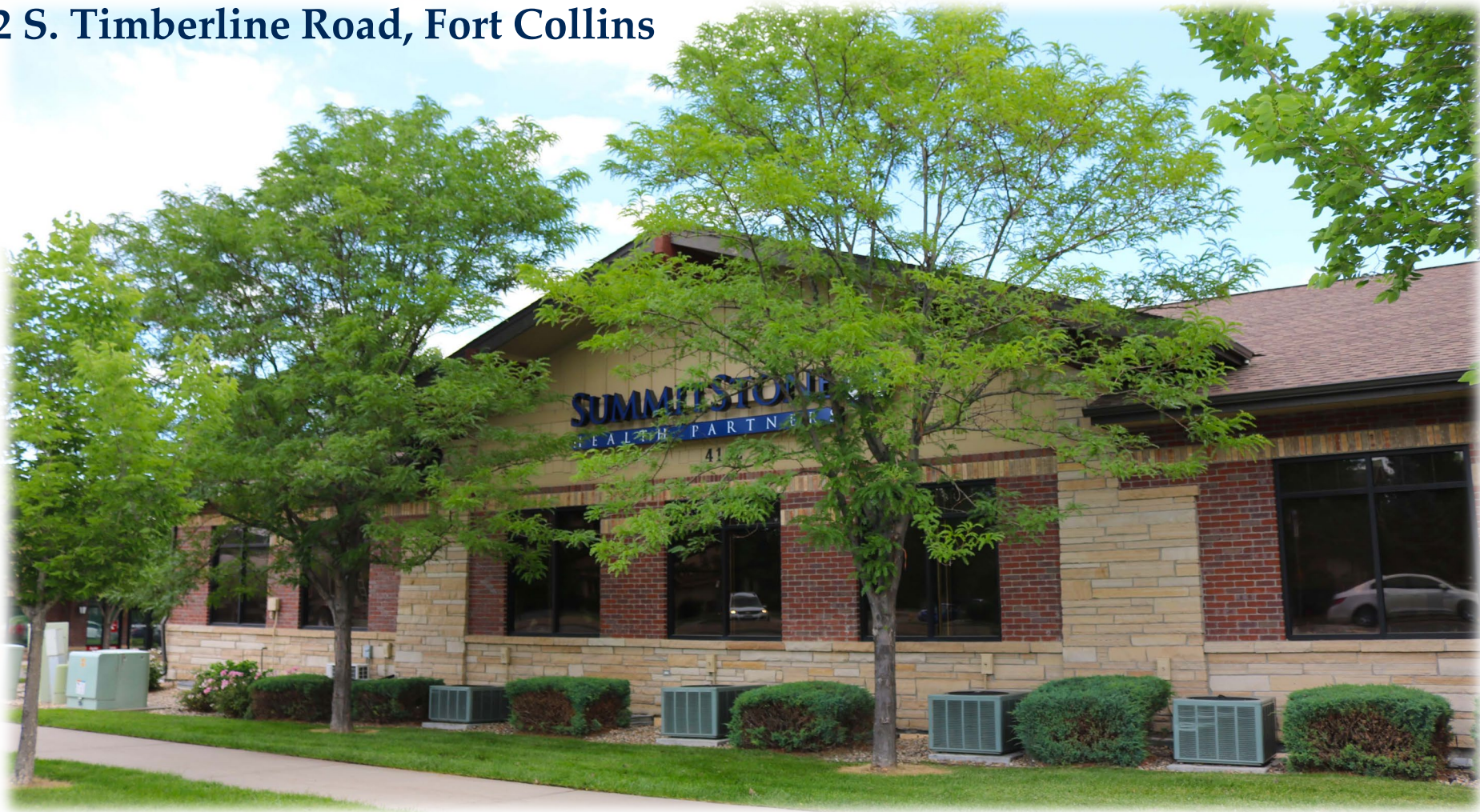

## Crisis Support Services

### Behavioral Health Urgent Care



- 8am – 12am: Walk- in assessment, crisis intervention and de-escalation for anyone experiencing a mental health or substance use crisis
- Referral and follow up

### Mobile Crisis



- 24/ 7/ 365 Response
- Paired response capacity during peak times
- Co-response with law enforcement

### Crisis Stabilization Unit



- 10 bed acute treatment for adults/up to 5 day stay
- New admissions accepted 24/7/365

# Larimer County Behavioral Health Services at Longview

In 2018, voters approved a measure to fund a behavioral health facility in Larimer County. SummitStone received the contract to provide services along with UCHHealth. This integrated care facility will provide licensed, equitable and culturally relevant care and treatment to individuals in crisis with mental health and/or substance use disorders. Services at Longview will be available to everyone in Larimer County who needs urgent intervention for mental health and/or substance use.

- Located at 2260 West Trilby Road in southwest Fort Collins, near the border with Loveland, will provide a central location for all Larimer County residents.
- Expected to open in late 2023
- Offering local access to critical services
- 200 jobs in Larimer County

Ribbon cutting tentatively scheduled for September 2023



# How We Use Community Donations

## Services for Clients Who are Uninsured and Underinsured



- Sliding scale services (including no cost)
- Non-billable services such as food, transportation, care follow-up
- Services to people who are undocumented or who have migrant or refugee status

# Year in Review

- ▶ 5,231 Youth Provided with Suicide Prevention Education in School
- ▶ 620 Youth Directly Referred to a Mental Health Professional
- ▶ 771 People Reached through Peer Outreach
- ▶ 4,420 Adults Served Through Suicide Prevention Education
- ▶ 152 People Served Through Grief Support
- ▶ Over 450 Gun safes/Medication Lockboxes Distributed to the Public
- ▶ Over 650 Adults and Youth Attended Imagine Zero Events
- ▶ Suicide rate decreased 12% from 2019 to 2021 in Larimer County

# Making the Biggest Impact

## Old Paradigm

- ▶ Focus Funding to Non-Profits Who Are Very Financially Secure
- ▶ Only Fund Evidenced Based Programming
- ▶ Fund Only Intervention Based Programming
- ▶ Fund the Best Individual Org
- ▶ Select Based on Pathos

## New Paradigm

- ▶ Dollars Go Further With Smaller/Newer Orgs
- ▶ Innovative New Approaches to Old Problems
- ▶ An Ounce of Prevention is Worth a Pound of Intervention (Fund Both)
