

The Family Development Program focuses on families or individuals establishing a partnership with a trained family advocate to set goals using a strengths-based family-centered approach to improve health and well-being.








2022 FAMILY STRENGTHENING PROGRAM ACCOMPLISHMENTS

- 47 Active Intakes (Households)
- 13 Families accomplished development goals
- 213 different services provided (Individual or Family)
- Inclusive of weekly & monthly playgroups, programs, classes; special programs, EVICS served 750 people of the Estes Valley in 2022.










Some of what families said about EVICS in 2022:




ENGLISH AS SECOND LANGUAGE

- Started with 1 teacher and 8 students
- Grown to 6 volunteer teachers, over 75 attendees, 3 levels of classes plus tutoring groups
- Large waitlist
- Additional languages (Russian & Ukrainian)










CHILDCARE TUITION ASSISTANCE

- 2022 over \$44,000 in tuition assistance
- 7 providers registered
- 37 families applied for tuition assistance
- Supported applications for CCAP and LCCF

Social Events and professional development are offered monthly as a way to bring EC Leaders together to network and collaborate. This program provides the support local Early Childhood professionals need to stay in this vital business. We provide materials, training curriculum, and supplies, all free of charge.

Six to ten educators regularly attend these monthly events.





BILINGUAL SOCIAL EMOTIONAL BACKPACKS FREE CHECK OUT FOR FAMILIES AND EARLY CHILDCARE EDUCATORS

500 Bilingual Story Time kits are distributed to families in the community from January to May.

Twenty-five more kits are distributed monthly to families visiting EVICS.




CHILD DEVELOPMENTAL SCREENING/ASQ












DIAPER BANK

We supply families with diapers in sizes newborn through size 6 and also pull-ups through size 4T. Generous donors support this program and the ability for EVICS to offer specialized items to meet children and family need, such as formula, specific diapers, and items that are often cost prohibitive to local families.









DIAPER BANK


- 20+ families receiving diapers monthly

- 50+ individuals served



Parent Attending To The Child's Needs










CIRCLE OF SECURITY




HOW DO WE SUPPORT THE HISPANIC COMMUNITY?
