A collaboration of churches with HNS serving alongside





The Landing


- The first Northern Colorado Regional Youth Shelter.

- Supported through Transformational Grants through Larimer County and Department of Local Affairs
- Will serve 20 youth and young adults nightly
- 200-250 youth and young adults served though drop in services.
- Groundbreaking on May 2 and opening in Nov/Dec 2024
